THE RULES



1. **Entries close online on the 3rd October 2023. The Wairarapa Agricultural and Pastoral Show (Wairarapa A&P Show) Secretary will permit NO late entries or substitute entries, to ensure full compliance with the Wairarapa A&P Society's show Biosecurity Plan.**
2. The term "Wairarapa A&P Show Secretary" means the respective Beef and Dairy section stewards, as applicable, in this document, who are the delegated cattle management authorities for the Wairarapa A&P Show Committee.
3. **All animals entered must be named on the entry form along with the RFID Nait number of each individual animal** (Instructions on how to find each animals RFID number at the end of the rules).
4. In accordance with the Royal Agricultural Society of New Zealand (RAS) codes, all entries must be registered with a RAS affiliated Society or if under 12 months of age be eligible for registration.
5. Entries are submitted to the rules and regulations of the Wairarapa A&P Society, copies are available from the Show Secretary.
6. The Wairarapa A&P Show Secretary reserves the right to combine judging classes if insufficient entries are received.
7. All entry fees are GST inclusive. A GST tax invoice can be supplied on request from the show secretary.
8. Entry Tickets will be sent to exhibitors.
9. Prize money is 1st \$20, 2nd \$10 and 3rd \$5 unless otherwise stated.
10. All animals are to be marshalled on site at the Wairarapa A&P Show Secretary's discretion. The Wairarapa A&P Show Secretary will schedule and manage access to the animal Bio-Security Wash Bay facilities. The Wairarapa A&P Show secretary will discuss Bio-Security arrangements with exhibitors and agree the Bio-Security protocols once entries have been submitted and accepted by the Show Secretary.
11. Exhibitors must display, on each animal entered, an operable Nait approved Radio Frequency Identification Display (RFID) tag, necessary to obtain entry to the Wairarapa A&P Show site. Exhibitors agree that they will ensure they comply with Ministry of Primary Industries Animal Handling codes, Nait, and the Wairarapa A&P Show Secretary's directives at all times during the Wairarapa A&P Show.
12. Every and any objection or protest must be made in writing within one hour of judging of each class, and signed by the person making the objection(s) and delivered to the Show Secretary along with the sum of \$50 which shall be forfeited to the Society should the objection be considered frivolous, vexatious,

dishonest, misleading or incomplete, following appropriate investigation by the Secretary in consultation with approved Judges. The Show Secretary's decision is final.

13. Trophies will be presented to exhibitors and it is the responsibility of such exhibitor to have trophies engraved at exhibitor's expense and in keeping with the lettering style used on each trophy. Custody of all trophies presented requires an acknowledged receipt by the awarded exhibitor, which shall be lodged with the Show Secretary before removal of the trophy from the show site at the discretion of the show Secretary.
14. All 2022 trophy holders are required to return awarded trophies to the Wairarapa A&P Society prior to Friday 27th October 2023. Please ensure all damaged trophies have been repaired, engraved and have been cleaned.
15. All animals are to be under competent supervision at all times.
16. All Bulls must be securely tied in the stalls by an adequate chain around the neck or a stout leather collar with adequate rope attached, as well as a halter, to the satisfaction of the Show Secretary.
17. Please bring your own water feeders for your cattle. There are no common troughs available.
18. All electrical equipment to have a current electrical compliance safety tag fitted.
19. The Hicks family Pavilion / Pig Pavilion loading ramps are off limits at all times.
20. All cattle must be entered in the name of the Nait registered Owner.
21. **All Animals must be named on entry form with individual Nait RFID number** including pairs or group classes.
22. Animal Cruelty is NOT acceptable in any way including but not limited to excessive handling or medical manipulation.

Nait Compliance Definition and Requirements

All stock must be NAIT registered and in accordance with OSPRI and TBfree New Zealand. Regardless of age they must be

- Departing from a property that is registered with a NAIT number and TBfree NZ herd number accompanied with a copy of a valid Animal Status Declaration form.
- Fitted with a valid NAIT RFID tag and registered in the NAIT system.
- **Registered in a movement to the event NAIT number (454124) from the animal's current NAIT number no later than Friday 27th October. Please bring a copy of your Nait transfer with you.**
- Registered in a return movement from the event NAIT number to their destination (receiving NAIT number) within 48 hours of departure.
- All stock over 90 days of age travelling from within a TBfree Movement Control Area must be pre-movement tested within 60 days of arriving at the event.
- All TBfree forms and Nait transfers will be collected upon arrival and animals Nait

tag Scanned in their **stall**.

- In accordance with MPI regulations the Wairarapa A&P Show operates a policy of **No Nait, No Show, No exceptions**.
- **ALL ANIMALS ARE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE OWNER**

Biosecurity and Wairarapa A&P Show Practice Policy

Wairarapa A&P Society take Biosecurity very seriously so we require our competitors to please adhere to the following rules

- The animal wash bays **must** be sprayed down with the Virkon supplied before and after each stud use, and **kept clean at all times**. One stud only at a time per washbay as per the time slot provided.
- No new Cattle exhibitor can be stalled in a pen previously used by another stud exhibitor, unless all bedding has been removed and replaced with fresh bedding with all rails and flooring disinfected (Fully sprayed wet) with Virkon disinfectant.
- Unless an animal is either at the wash bay, in the ring or moving between, all animals must be kept within their stalling area.
- Please do not share buckets, troughs, brushes or grooming equipment with other exhibitors.
- There will be Hand Sanitizer provided in the pavilion.
- In the interest of Bio-security a “keep left” and “giveaway” to the right approach will be taken for animals entering and exiting the stalls and using raceways. A 2-meter gap between exhibitor stalls must be adhered to at all times to the satisfaction of the Stewards.
- All exhibitors are responsible for keeping their stalls clean and tidy at all times, including poo removal. To assist with this each exhibitor will be given an area with which to store their gear.
- All electrical equipment to have a current electrical compliance safety tag fitted.
- There is a NO SMOKING / NO VAPING policy in the Cattle Pavilion – it the responsibility of all to remind the general public of this.
- If you are requiring extra people to attend to assist you, please make sure they are fully compliant with the above rules.

To find **EACH individual animal RFID** number you must have the animal registered in the NAIT system. If you need help with this, please visit ospri.co.nz or call 0800 482 463.

If your animal is already registered with Nait, you then need to log on to NAIT with your NAIT Account ID number and then click on "registered animals" on the drop down screen menu as shown in the example below:

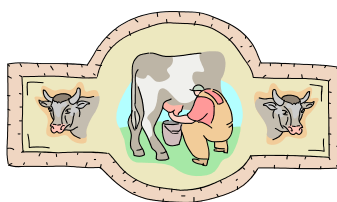

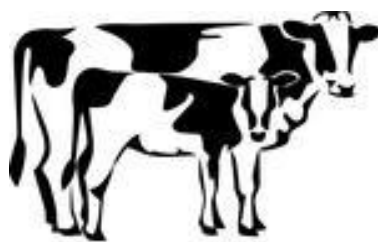

Certification must be sent to the secretary when requested for full points in production. To qualify, heifers and cows accumulative protein and fat record in the previous or qualifying lactation must total greater than:

325 kgs P + F as a 2 year old;

350 kgs P + F as a 3 year old;

400 kgs P + F as a 4 year old; and

For cows five year old and over five years lactation they must have produced at least 450 kgs P + F on any one record.

PRODUCTION: Each cow qualifying in terms of clause 2 will be allotted 80 points for the relative qualifying production.

For production exceeding the qualifying basis as above, points will be allotted as follows - 1 point for every 5 kgs of milk solids (maximum of 20 points) and also less 1 point for every 5 kgs of milksolids (maximum of 20 points), for those under qualifying production.

Conditions of Entry:

1. The competition will be open to all cows under group herd test.
2. The cow must have calved since 1 June the year of showing and be in milk.
3. The entries will be classified as follows: 5 years & over; 4 year old; 3 year old; 2 year old.
4. The lactation period upon which production points are assessed to be that last completed. Prior to the Show and to be no more than 305 days. The cow must have calved the season prior to the season producing the qualification figures. For other cows which have completed only one lactation on which production points are assessed, must have been not more than 410 days after calving for the lactation preceding that one.
5. The minimum standards of production based on the previous season's lactation in all cases to be as follows:
5 years and over - 450 kgs milk solids;
4 year old - 400 kgs milk solids;
3 year old - 350 kgs milk solids;
2 year old - 325 kgs milk solids.
6. All entries must have been tested in the previous season, except in the case of 2 year olds.
7. **PRODUCTION:** Each cow qualifying in terms of clause 2 will be allotted 80 points for the relative qualifying production. For production exceeding the qualifying basis as above, points will be allotted as follows - 1 point for every 5 kgs of milk solids (maximum of 20 points) and also less 1 point for every 5 kgs of milksolids (maximum of 20 points), for those under qualifying production.
8. **TYPE:** A maximum of 100 points to be allotted to the first placing and others to be pointed down from this standard. Average of 3 judges to be counted
9. Production figures for the season on which figures are to be assessed to be submitted for that season and age at commencement of that lactation at time of entry.
The official LIA production certificate **MUST** accompany entries for this class.
