Class

- 500 Bowls wooden items that have been turned on the lathe into a bowl shape. Can be decorated, coloured etc.
- 501 Plates/Platters

Wooden items which may be decorated with other materials and have been turned to a platter or plate shape. The height must not exceed 20% of the diameter – eg. A 250mm diameter piece must not exceed 50mm in height.

502 Hollow form/Vases

The opening in hollow forms must be at least 1/3rd narrower than the widest part of the form.

503 Lidded Boxes

Lidded boxes must have a form fitting lid.

504 Open Artistic/Ornamental

Can be turned or carved and include the following works. Intarsia, marquetry, scroll saw, poker work etc.
