125 grams melted butter

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup castor sugar

2 $\frac{1}{2}$ crushed weetbix

2 tbs cocoa

1 cup flour

1 cup coconut

1 tsp baking powder

Mix all dry ingredients in a bowl, add melted butter.

Press into a 20cm tin bake in moderate oven for 10 minutes.

Marshmallow Topping.

Use Electric beater.

Dissolve 2 level dts gelatine in 1 cup boiling water.

2 small cups sugar beat until fluffy and pour onto base.

(Vanilla optional)

Store in an airtight container.

(Made using recipe provided below)

Cake

175 g butter, softened.	1 teaspoon baking powder
$\frac{3}{4}$ cup sugar	2 teaspoons cinnamon
3 eggs	$\frac{1}{2}$ cup raspberry jam
1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups plain flour, sifted.	$\frac{1}{4}$ cup chopped nuts

Grease an 18cm square cake tin.

Cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy.

In a separate bowl beat eggs until thick.

Sift flour and baking powder together. Add to creamed mixture alternately with the eggs.

Transfer one-third of the mixture to a bowl. Stir in cinnamon. Reserve remaining mixture

Spoon cinnamon mixture into a greased and lined 18cm square cake tin.

Spread surface with raspberry jam. Then top with reserved mixture.

Sprinkle the top with chopped nuts.

Bake at 180°C for 50 minutes or until cake springs back when lightly touched.

Leave in tin for 5 to 10 minutes before turning out onto a wire rack.
