125 grams melted butter
$3 / 4$ cup castor sugar
$21 / 2$ crushed weetbix
2 tbls cocoa
1 cup flour
1 cup coconut
1 tsp baking powder

Mix all dry ingredients in a bowl, add melted butter.
Press into a 20 cm tin bake in moderate oven for 10 minutes.

## Marshmallow Topping.

Use Electric beater.
Dissolve 2 level dts gelatine in 1 cup boiling water.
2 small cups sugar beat until fluffy and pour onto base.
(Vanilla optional)

Store in an airtight container.

## Cake

| 175 g butter, softened. | 1 teaspoon baking powder |
| :--- | :--- |
| $3 / 4$ cup sugar | 2 teaspoons cinnamon |
| 3 eggs | $1 / 2$ cup raspberry jam |
| $1 \frac{1}{2}$ cups plain flour, sifted. | $1 / 4$ cup chopped nuts |

Grease an 18 cm square cake tin.

Cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy.

In a separate bowl beat eggs until thick.

Sift flour and baking powder together. Add to creamed mixture alternately with the eggs.

Transfer one-third of the mixture to a bowl. Stir in cinnamon. Reserve remaining mixture

Spoon cinnamon mixture into a greased and lined 18 cm square cake tin.

Spread surface with raspberry jam. Then top with reserved mixture.

Sprinkle the top with chopped nuts.

Bake at $180^{\circ} \mathrm{C}$ for 50 minutes or until cake springs back when lightly touched.

Leave in tin for 5 to 10 minutes before turning out onto a wire rack.
