ENTRY FORMS:

Entry forms to be received by Wednesday 16th October 2024

Under no circumstances are they to be enclosed in the parcel with exhibits. This will disqualify the entries from the competition.

One Exhibitor's ticket only, will be given with entries totaling \$15.00 and over. This will be emailed to the Exhibitor.

ENTRY FEE – all exhibits \$1.00 (Minimum Charge \$5.00)

EXHIBITS:

Each separate exhibit must have attached an envelope with the class Number on the outside. Inside must have the exhibitor's name. Exhibits will be disqualified if this rule is not complied with. (And may be misplaced)

All entries should be accompanied by a list with name & address of exhibitor & description and class number of each item entered.

All parcels must be marked on the outside with the appropriate section e.g. "Spinning & Weaving".

Please pack separately from the Knitting, Woollens, Crafts.

All local entries and exhibits to be delivered to the A&P Secretary, Clareville Complex between 10am Monday 21st October – 3pm Tuesday 29th October 2024 (please note that the A&P Secretary's Office is not open over the weekend. Drop-off can be organized outside normal hours by arrangement).

Entries which have not been delivered by the closing date (Tuesday 29th October 2024) CANNOT be accepted at the stadium.

CLASS:

- 230 A skein of fine wool equivalent to 4ply or finer.
- 231 A skein of wool equivalent to 8ply or thicker.
- 232 A skein of any natural fibre or mixture of fibres
(Please state fibres e.g. alpaca, mohair, silk etc.).
- 233 A garment to fit a child aged two or older. Hand spun yarn, any technique.
- 234 A garment to fit an adult. Hand spun yarn, any technique.
- 235 A blanket or baby shawl in hand spun wool, any technique.
- 236 A hat, any technique.
- 237 A pair of socks or gloves (not mittens). Hand spun yarn, any technique.
- 238 Any felted item.
- 239 A woven item. Some hand spun yarn preferred but not required.
- 240 A neck/shoulder garment, any technique.
